The practice of placing stored collections on public view without interpretation or planned educational content.

original order

The archival principle that records should be maintained in the order in which they were placed by the organization, individual, or family that created them (Daniels and Walch 1986).

overblow

A term often associated with the mould-blowing process, describing that small portion of the paraison, after its insertion into the mould, which forms between the blow-pipe and the mould. After the annealing process, the overblow is removed, usually by cracking off.
